Overview

Each year we undertake an assessment on the impact our charity is having on the lives of our attendees, and the lives of their parent/s or guardian/s.

We carry out this assessment by way of a survey, completed jointly by attendees, parent/s or guardians.

Our surveys are always anonymous and purely voluntary to complete.

Prior to attending our sessions did they have school attendance issues?

22.20% answered YES with 100% reporting positive results

Of which - 46.6% reported a Marked Improvement

Of which - 34% reported a Marked Improvement
48.75% reported an Improvement
17.25% reported a Slight Improvement

33.3% answered YES with 100% reporting positive results

Of which - 29% reported a Marked Improvement
45.75% reported an Improvement
25.25% reported a Slight Improvement

Prior to attending our sessions did they have problems with physical activity?

50% answered YES with 100% reporting positive results
Of which - 36% reported a Marked Improvement
58% reported an Improvement
6% reported a Slight Improvement

Prior to attending our sessions did they have problems with self-respect?

22.25% answered YES with all reporting positive results
Of which - 18.75% reported a Marked Improvement
50% reported an Improvement
31.25% reported a Slight Improvement

Prior to attending our sessions did they have problems respecting others and property?

19.5% answered YES with 100% reporting positive results
Of which - 14.5% reported a Marked Improvement
50% reported an Improvement
35.5% reported a Slight Improvement

33.3% answered YES with 83% reporting positive results
Of which - 21% reported a Marked Improvement
29% reported an Improvement
33% reported a Slight Improvement
17% reported No Change
(The only non-positive result)
